LISTEN

- Take the risk and put yourself out there for others.
 - Remember to weigh the pro's and con's of every decision you make.
- You need to have the confidence, courage, motivation, and vision.

DELEGATE

- Be able to delegate tasks to peers
 - Provide opportunity for others to lead
 - Effective Communication is **KEY**
- Do not be afraid to ask to get things done
 - A team is there to support YOU, and in return, remember to support THEM.
- You are **not ALONE**.

ENERGY

- A leader must be able to provide a **POSITIVE** learning environment for others to grow in.
- When the "*going gets tough*" there is a necessity for a boost of energy.
 - BE THE **SUPPORT** SYSTEM FOR OTHERS
- Motivate others to take initiative!

RESPECT

As a leader, you should always respect others.

 - You are a representative of the greater organization.
- Your actions *influence* others.

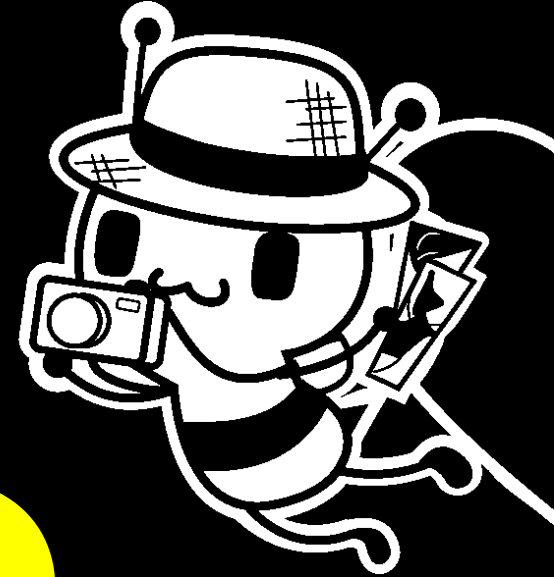
