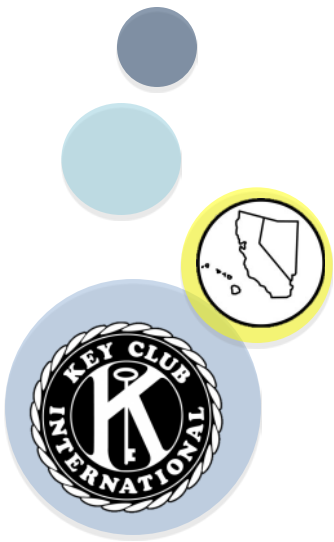

“Key Club is an international student-led organization which provides its members with opportunities to provide service, build character and develop leadership.”

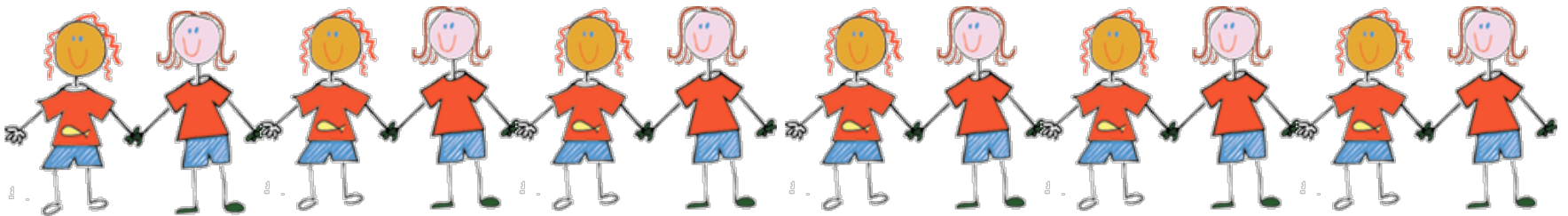
Our mission statement is here to remind us what our goal is as Key Club International for each and every member. We are organizations that change the lives of young adults in a positive light through service.

- This past year, CNH has finished countless hours and raised over \$100,000 for a noble cause called Pediatric Trauma Prevention

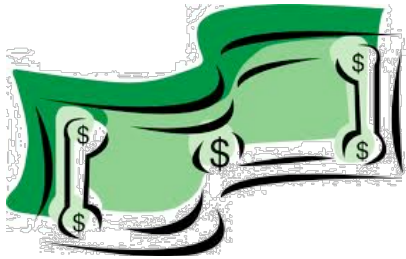


FUN FACTS:

PAY YOUR DUES

To officially be a part of Key Club International, you **HAVE** to pay your club dues. Key Club dues are **\$11** and all proceeds go to keeping Key Club alive and running, as well as maintain your Key Club insurance in case you get injured during a service event!
