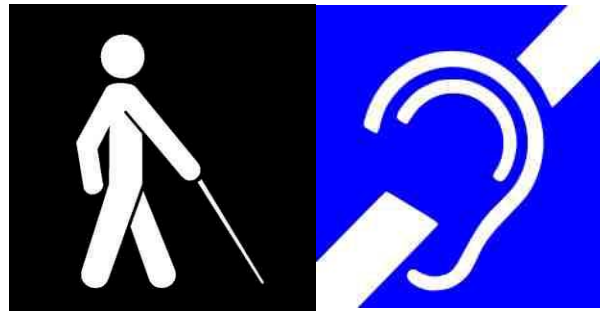
Cerebral Palsy

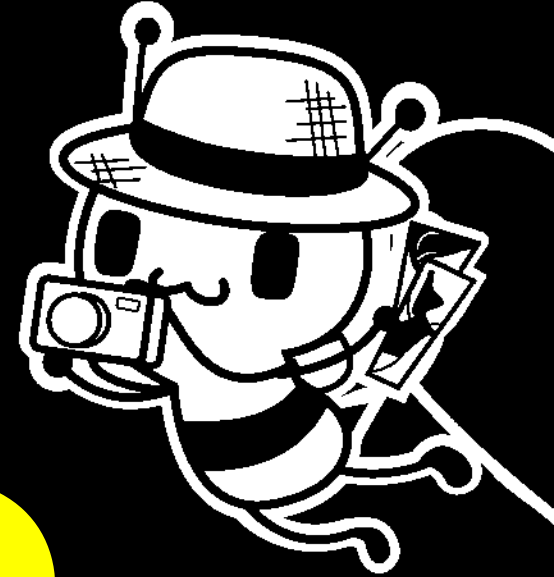
