- Limited copies of your literature may be printed by the District Office for distribution at your display.

Display

- Each exhibit will be provided one table
- Table dimensions is 8 ft. in diameter; other specifics will be provided in acceptance letter
- Display must fit on the table
- Exhibit locations are based on availability and registration
- No sales of any kind are permitted at the exhibit
- Exhibit display should contain the project's goal, information on partnering organizations, and other information to promote
- A maximum of 3 people supervising the display at all times
