- For 10 or more boxes, order online at unicefusa.org/trickortreat or call 1-800-FOR-KIDS.
- Individual boxes can be picked-up at Hallmark Gold Crown starting September 1, 2008 or Pier 1 Imports and stores starting October 1, 2008. To locate the store nearest you, visit unicefusa.org/trickortreat.

Donate your funds. There are three ways to make a **Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF** donation — by credit card, Coinstar Center[®] or check.

- By Credit Card – Donations can be made online at unicefusa.org/trickortreat or by calling 1-800-FOR-KIDS.
- Through Coinstar Centers – For the past eleven years, participants in the **Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF** program have been able to empty the coins collected in their orange boxes into Coinstar Centers and quickly donate to UNICEF. The Coinstar Center counts change quickly and prints a receipt for the full amount of the tax-deductible contribution. Send the receipt with your name and address to the address below, and the U.S. Fund for UNICEF will mail an official acknowledgement of the gift.
