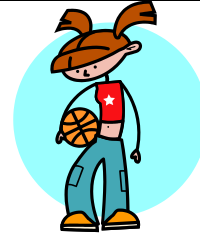

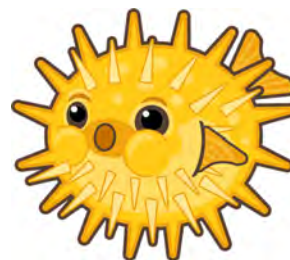
Divisional T-shirts!
