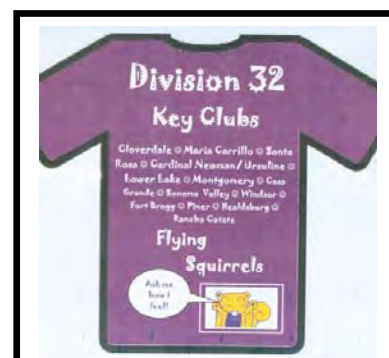
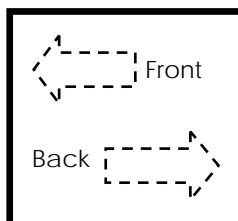


FALL RALLY
