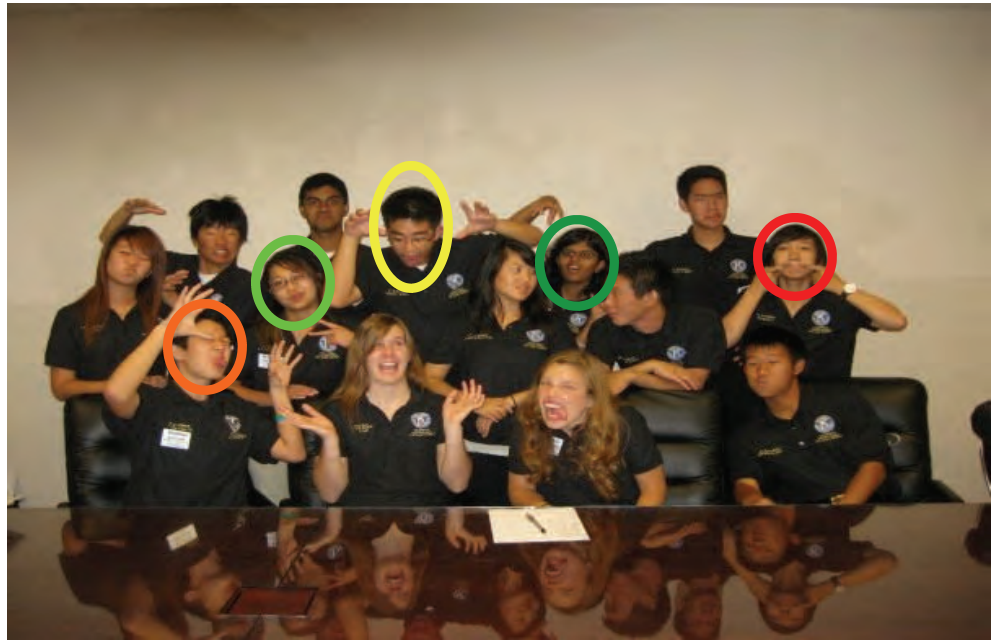

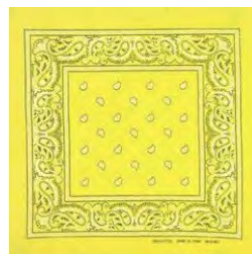

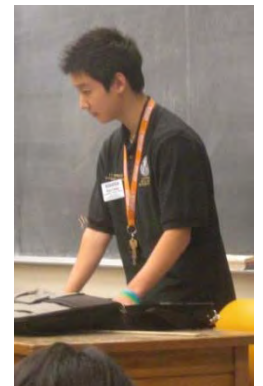

UNICEF is one of Key Club International's official *Partners in Service*; it is an acronym for United Nations International Children's Education Fund.

Though there are many service projects that can be done to raise money for UNICEF, the ultimate idea of this service project is to go trick-or-treating not for candy, but for money that will be donated to those in need. 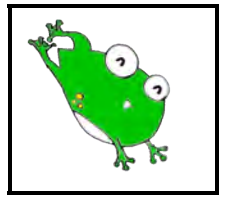
