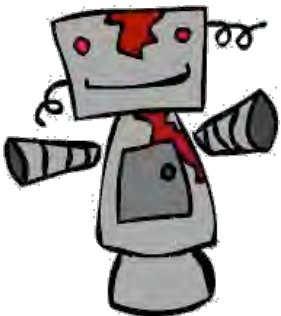
What's snappin' Region 1?

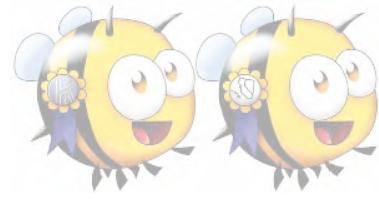

Holding Key Club meetings

Before the first meeting:

- Create a club flyer and post them around campus and in classrooms a week prior to your first meeting.
- Ask your teacher to email all the teachers and at the last 10 minutes of a period, go into freshmen classrooms and make a quick announcement about community service and what Key Club is about.
- Make a SCENE – have all your officers wear matching shirts, start a spirit rally before your meeting begins, buy small noisemakers, etc. Get creative!
- Provide an incentive – free cookies!

For normal meetings:

- Have 2-3 events ready to talk about and create an event sign-in sheet for each event.
- Have a weekly sign in sheet to track attendance.
- Invite guest speakers! If you're planning to volunteer at a breast cancer relay, ask the organization nicely if they could send a volunteer coordinator to one of your meetings and educate your members.
- Invite your Kiwanis members! They love seeing what your club is up to.
- Pass out membership packets and explain dues by the third meeting.
- Start meetings off with an icebreaker or question for all the members to answer.
