updates on fundraising for PTP!



Hey everyone! PTP Fundraising has been looking great so far. With lots of American Apparel Hoodie sales and club fundraising from Santa Teresa and Leland, we have reached a total of \$808.48! We are almost close to my goal! At the last PCM (President's Council Meeting), your presidents came up with a goal of \$1800 (About \$200 fundraised from each school.) Keep up with the PTP Fundraising!

What is PTP?

PTP Stands for Pediatric Trauma Prevention Program. The PTP focuses to develop local projects, which will reduce the number of children who are killed or injured by accidents. The Foundation provides funding to train pediatric doctors, nurses and first responders, to purchase pediatric medical equipment, and to create or expand community outreach programs.

What does PTP have to do with Fall Rally North?

Fall Rally North (and South) is our largest fundraiser for PTP. At the FRN General Session, Lt. Governors are auctioned off for the day at Great America. The money fundraised for PTP will be the money that each division has to spend at the auction. So please buy me for the day. ☺

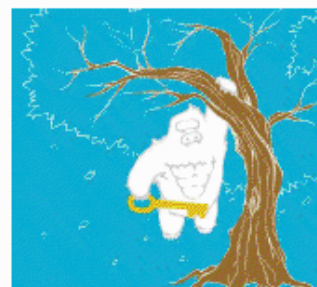
