Housing (1 form per every 4 Key Clubbers of the same gender, don't forget a form for your advisors! **Pick the Sheraton!**)

Walk For Life (A PTP Fundraiser, real simple, fill out the form, make a donation, get a ribbon, and join the walk. Onsite registration also available.)

Club Elections

Every club needs to hold club elections to elect officers for the upcoming year between the months of February and March. 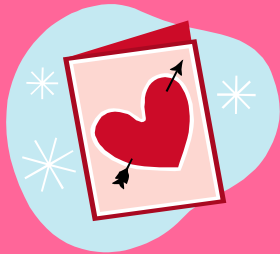

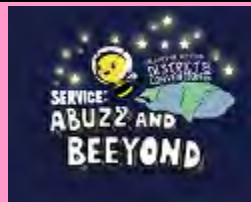
