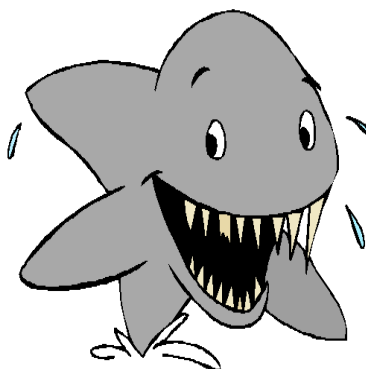

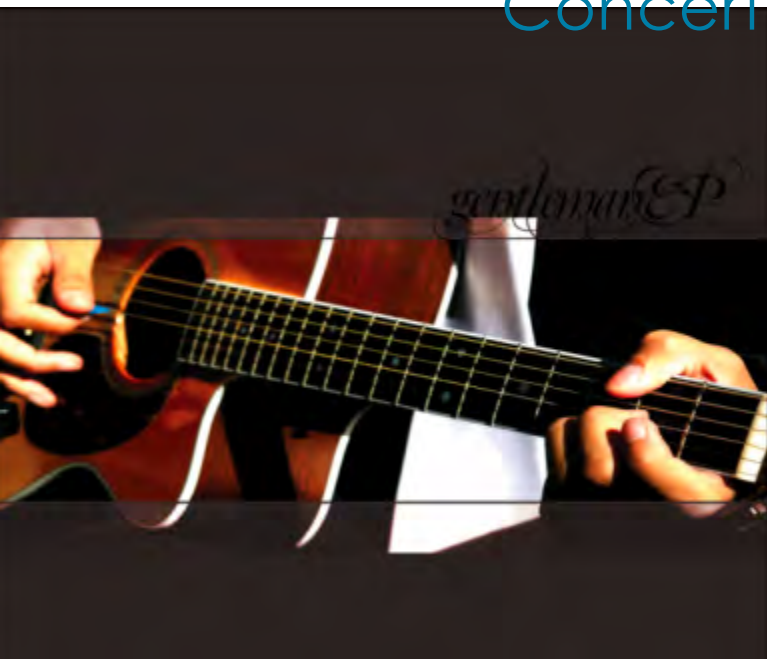
Fall Rally
