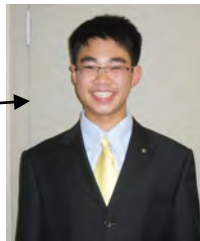

Cali-Nev-Ha Visuals are visuals that can be submitted by any Key Club member. Visuals can be pictures that show Key Clubbers working hard during service projects.

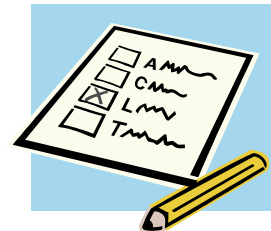

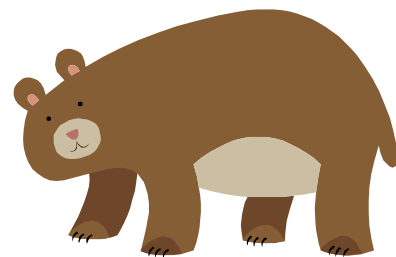

CLUB ELECTIONS

I noticed that several clubs in our division had very late elections last year, but we can fix that mistake this year!

Plan for elections starting NOW. Here's a timeline:

- Early/Mid-January - Have an informational meeting for Key Clubbers interested in running for a position, and give them applications at the end of the meeting.

- Middle/End of January - Set a date for the application deadline sometime during this period. During a board meeting, set aside time to screen applicants (based on service hours, meeting attendance, general attitude, etc).

- February - Hold elections after a general meeting! Each candidate should deliver a two-minute speech, and after everyone's done, the members should ask the candidate group questions for five minutes. Hold a secret ballot, and have an ADVISOR count the votes.

- February-End of School Year - Train your officers-elect! Also, please send the new officers' names and contact info to me RIGHT AFTER elections. Secretaries, there's an Election tab in your MRF just for that purpose.

REMEMBER!

- ABSOLUTELY NO CO-OFFICERS! Only one President, Secretary, and Treasurer can be elected.

- Although multiple Vice Presidents are allowed to be elected, they are not necessary for small clubs. If your club has 80+ members, consider adding a slot for an extra Vice President. If your club has less than 80 members, then it doesn't really need an extra VP.

- You can also elect a Bulletin Editor (BE) or Public Relations Coordinator (PRC), but most clubs appoint a member to that position.

- Committee chairs are to be appointed by the officers when school starts in the fall. Examples: Fundraising, Technology, Scrapbook, etc. However, you should only appoint the chairs your club NEEDS; don't appoint chairs for the sake of giving away positions.

- And if you think I left something important out, let me know! :]

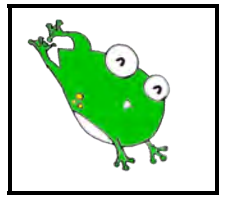
