
What is CMN? It is a non-profit organization that raises funds for children's hospitals, medical research and community awareness of children health issues

About them: Since 1983, Children's Miracle Network Hospitals has raised more than \$5 billion—most of it \$1 at a time—for 170 children's hospitals across the United States and Canada, which, in turn, use the money where it's needed the most.

These donations have gone to support research and training, purchase equipment, and pay for uncompensated care, all to save and improve the lives of as many children as possible.

Why is CMN important?

62 Children enter a Children's Miracle Network Hospital for treatment every minute - that's one child every second. Some are suffering from a traumatic injury. Others require constant care because they were born too early, or with a genetic disease.



How to help?

- Provide toys and dolls for kids doing through trauma.
- Contribute to or create videos, to or book lending libraries or playrooms.
- Help staff information booths or surgery waiting rooms.
- Assist families with children who require long-term care or who live great distances from hospitals.
- Support safety campaigns or parent education programs.
