MAJOR EMPHASIS



WHAT DOES ICON HAVE TO OFFER?

- ★ Attend the entire convention, July 5-9, and stay with the district at the hotel. For US\$265, you get a three-day experience of bonding with fellow members, attending all workshops, and participating in elections. The convention hotel is \$213.77/night for a double room.
- ★ Purchase a one-day pass for Friday, July 7. For US\$150, you can join the convention on that date and attend four workshops, the leadership luncheon, the recognition session, and the dessert reception.
- ★ Purchase a Key Club event discounted Disneyland ticket. The CNH District will be attending Disneyland on Wednesday, July 5. The discounted ticket price is \$215 for a Park Hopper ticket and \$150 for a single park ticket.
- ★ The CNH District has created a Google Sheet where you can list your name and find other CNH Key Clubbers who are looking to share a hotel room. Use this sheet to also list your room along with you roommates.
- ★ Reserve your hotel room along with your roommates. Hotel room rate is \$181 per night (\$213.77 after taxes/fees). So for 4 nights (July 5 – 9) the total hotel cost would be \$855.08.
