WHAT IS DCON?

 District Convention (DCON) is an annual event to celebrate the achievements of the past year, to elect the new district officers, attend workshops, and meet new people. The California-Nevada-Hawai'i (CNH) District of Key Club International is comprised of 40,000+ high school students from all 3 states.

WHERE/WHEN/COST?

- Grand Sierra Resort (2500 E 2nd St, Reno, NV 89595).
- March 13th-15th, 2020.
- On-Time Registration: January 28th, 2020 (cost TBA).
- Late Registration: February 11th, 2020 (cost TBA).
- Registration fee covers all convention activities, Saturday breakfast/lunch/dinner, Sunday breakfast, and convention souvenirs.
- Bring extra money for meals during travel, meals on Friday night, and extra snacks.

WHY ATTEND?

- Celebrate the annual recognition of officers, members and advisors
- Experience the district talent show and keynote speaker.
- Experience the bittersweet moments of congratulating and welcoming the 2020-2021 District Board while saying goodbye to the 2019-2020 District Board.

WHAT ARE THE EVENT SAFETY MEASURES?

- Attendance is restricted to dues-paid Key Club members and chaperones.
- Chaperones must have an up to date criminal background check, conducted by Safe Hiring Solutions, within the past two years. Cost of the background check is included in the registration fee.
- The chaperone ratio is 1 chaperone for every 10 members and is also gender specific.
- All attendees (including chaperones) must sign a code of conduct, which includes curfew, dress code, and behavior standards.
- Leaving rooms past curfew (midnight) will not be tolerated.
- All attendees must wear convention wristbands and name tags for identification, which are verified by Sergeant-at-Arms before entry at meals, sessions, and workshops.

WHAT IS THE CONVENTION VENUE?

 All convention activities will take place in the Grand Sierra Resort Convention Center.

WHAT ARE THE HOTELS THAT WE CAN STAY IN?

• All attendees, including adults, must stay at the Grand Sierra Resort

• All travel arrangements to DCON must be made with the chaperones that are attending this event.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO COMPLETE ALONG WITH REGISTRATION?

- SAA Registration (two per club)
- Delegate Registration (two per club)
- Advisors need to book hotels for themselves as well as for the Key Club members they are responsible for.

WHAT IS AN SAA?

- SAA stands for Sergeant at Arms and their responsibility is to make sure the members at the convention are following all Code of Conduct guidelines.
- They will be monitoring all members to ensure that there will be no inappropriate behavior.
- They will help enforce District Convention rules (i.e. dress code).
