Overview of "UNICEF"

Key Club and UNICEF have partnered together for many causes, helping communities all over the world:

"Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF has empowered generations to make lasting change in their global community by collecting donations on Halloween to help save and protect children. Key Club has been Trick-or-Treating for UNICEF since 1994, raising over \$7 million.

Combating iodine deficiency worldwide and HIV and AIDS in Kenya and Swaziland are just some of the programs Key Club has supported.

Since 2011, Key Club's Trick-or-Treat donations have funded The Eliminate Project, which supports the elimination of maternal and neonatal tetanus globally."

EVENT IDEA

"HALLOWEEN GROUP"

Have volunteers go Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF by splitting everyone up into groups to compete for a prize! Split your volunteers into as many groups with as many people as you wish, then assign advisors to each group. Set a prize for the group that collects the most money by the end of the night! This could be food, tickets, gift cards, Key Club apparel, etc. Promote staying safe by trick-or-treating in groups and when asking for donations.

Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF

Since 1950, Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF has raised nearly \$177 million. Key Club International is partnered with UNICEF, raising funds for The Eliminate Project. Trick-or-Treat for UNICEF works in 190 countries around the world helping save and improve children's lives. A yearly campaign runs from early July to late June the following year. The busiest time of the year is most definitely October during Halloween as students go around with small cardboard boxes asking for coins as donations. These boxes can be ordered as early as late August as orders will start shipping before September 12th. The latest a club will be able to order is October 24th, so plan accordingly! When all coins are collected, do not send UNICEF any cash! Instead, make an equivalent donation to UNICEF using a credit card or writing a check. All donations are tax deductible and you will receive a receipt in the mail.

- \$5 FIVE DAYS OF FOOD FOR A MALNOURISHED CHILD
- \$15 A YEAR'S WORTH OF CLEAN, SAFE WATER FOR A CHILD
