How To Run This Event!

- 2. Gather members encourage them to be creative with their sock design
- Start/stop a stopwatch for this service event (to make sure your service counts!)
- 4. Deliver the socks to your loca; CMH hospital

Protip(s)!

- Ensure the socks you are purchasing come in all different colors, longths, and sizes
 - lengths, and sizes
- Place the sock on your non-dominant hand and paint with your dominant hand to ensure a mess-free event

How To Run This Event!
