Event Ideas

Interclubs Interact!

Many forms of interclub events with fellow Kiwanis branches can be held during the month of November. Find a form of virtual or in-person bonding that would best serve your club. For example, organizing events such as movie nights & talent shows can both be held in a virtual setting. As the Kiwanis Family is what makes Key Club stand out from other high school clubs, interclubs events such as these can help further your club's ability to increase attendance & connect your members with new people.



Service Project Ideas



Work with your branches of the Kiwanis Family to come together and dedicate a day to crafting! There can be a wide variety of crafts that your members can make such as origami, paper flowers, scrapbooking, and any other crafts of your choice! After your day of Kiwanis Krafts, donate them to places in need such as: schools, medical centers, elderly homes, etc. Repost pictures of the crafts your members make through your preferred social media site!

Letters to Kiwanis

Start a stopwatch after gathering pens, pencils, markers, and cards & work with your members on cards of gratitude for your Kiwanians. Letters to Kiwanis is a great way to dedicate time to display the gratitude for your local Kiwanians. This service event can be held during a Zoom meeting with your members or independently. Make sure you encourage your members to send pictures (unposed) of their process!

Fundraising

Invite your local Kiwanians and Key Club members for a (virtual!) night of trivia! Feel free to gather (Safekey) pop culture trivia as well as Key Club trivia questions. Compete with your members against the Kiwanis and total up your points at the end! Before playing, establish a way to donate the winnings. For example, for every point your club earns, the Kiwanis would have to donate \$0.50 to the Key Club. For every point the Kiwanis earned, your club would donate \$0.50 to a CNH preferred charity such as PTP!

Bingo Night

Similar to a Trivia Night, an in-person Bingo Night is a fun way to channel some competition among your members and the Kiwanis! If circumstances allow, work with your faculty advisor on finding a small venue to host your members, Kiwanians, and advisors. Work with all parties to find a date that works for all! Gather your Key Club members to volunteer as waiters, DJ's, and a bingo caller for additional service hours. On the day of the event, collect a small entrance fee to support your fundraising efforts for a charitable cause/your club's savings. Promote the event through social media & emails to your local Kiwanians and see who shouts BINGO first!
